Every Sunday morning at 6am via zoom and Wednesday evenings at 7pm in church, we as a church gather for prayer.



BIBLE STUDY

This month we focus on Adventist Fundamental Belief No. 2: The Trinity

There is one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, a unity of three coeternal Persons. God immortal, all-powerful, allknowing, above all, and ever present. He is infinite and beyond comprehension, human yet known through His selfrevelation. God, who is love, is forever worthy of worship, adoration, and service by the whole creation.

(Gen. 1:26; Deut. 6:4; Isa. 6:8; Matt. 28:19; John 3:16 2 Cor. 1:21, 22; 13:14; Eph. 4:4-6; 1 Peter 1:2.).

While the word "trinity" may not be in the Bible, the concept of this three-in-one Godhead is expressed in many places throughout the Bible.

"I and My Father are one," Jesus said in John 10:30.

Jesus' baptism was a time when all three members of the Trinity were involved. As Jesus came out of the water, the Holy Spirit came from Heaven. To the human eye, He looked like a dove. He hovered above Jesus, showing His approval. From the clouds, God the Father spoke, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased" (Luke 3:22).
